Acceptable Plastics



Polyethylene: Liquid Dish Soap, Salad Dressing, Ketchup Bottles
BBQ Sauce, Mayo & Peanut Butter Jars, Soft Drink Bottles
Mouthwash, Glass Cleaner or Any Bottle with a #1



High Density Polyethylene: Vitamin and Pain Medication Bottles,
Water, Milk & Juice Bottles, Vinegar & Mustard Bottles



Polyvinyl Chloride: Mineral Water, Charcoal Lighter Fluid, Shampoo,
Cooking Oil



Low Density Polyethylene: Fabric Softener Bottles, Sunscreen & Lotion
Bottles, Food Storage Containers



Polypropylene: Deli & Yogurt Containers, Medication Bottles



Polystyrene: Medication Bottles, Yogurt Containers, Clear Takeout
Containers



Microwave Containers, Cleaning Bottles, Syrup & Ketchup Bottles

Unacceptable Plastics



Toys & Garden Hoses
Place in the trash



Grocery Bags, Bubble Wrap
Can be returned to the grocery store



Styrofoam, Large Storage Containers
Place in the trash
